

## **Governor DeWine Signed House Bill 606**

Governor DeWine signed House Bill 606 on Monday, September 14, 2020.

This legislation will provide legal liability protections to businesses and other entities during COVID-19, as long as they have not shown reckless, intentional or willful misconduct. Read OMA's statement.

The new law will be effective December, 13, 2020. The qualified immunity provisions apply retroactively from March 9 and extend through Sept. 30, 2021.




